Qualifying period: Start anytime!

By applying to the college job, students will have four months from their Quick Start attendance date to:

1. Attend a presentation
2. Complete a Quick Start
3. Work with trainer to schedule a set appointments
4. Fulfill scholarship requirements



Scholarship Requirements

While in school, students can earn scholarships towards their higher education by originating & observing approved claims:

1st to 4th approved claim = \$100 scholarship per claim

5th approved claim = \$600 scholarship

6th to 9th approved claim = \$200 scholarship per claim

10th approved claim = \$1,200 scholarship

Maximum Scholarship Awarded Per LICENSED Student

\$5,500

Maximum Scholarship Awarded Per NON- LICENSED Student

\$5,000

ALL OTHER TRAINING REIMBURSEMENTS ARE IN ADDITION TO SCHOLARSHIP

1. Qualifying period begins from students Quick Start attendance date to four months after
